Tonight we will take you on a musical journey through some of Gilbert and Sullivan's work, including pieces from H.M.S. Pinafore and The Pirates of Penzance.

Jorvik Gilbert and Sullivan Company was formed in 2007, as an inclusive amateur company dedicated to performing the works of Gilbert and Sullivan.

Since their formation, they have performed eight fully staged productions in The Joseph Rowntree Theatre: *Patience* in 2009, *The Mikado* in 2010, *Princess Ida* in 2011, *H.M.S. Pinafore* in 2012, *Ruddigore* in 2013; *Iolanthe* in 2014; *The Sorcerer* in 2015 and *The Pirates of Penzance* in September 2016.

In 2017, Jorvik will be performing as part of The Joseph Rowntree Theatre's Community Choir Festival, as well as performing in Selby and Easingwold, before returning to The Joseph Rowntree Theatre in September, with a fully staged production of *The Yeoman of the Guard*.

The University of York Gilbert and Sullivan Society will celebrate the 45th anniversary in 2017, a year which will see them perform away from Central Hall for the first time, as they put on The Gondoliers at The Joseph Rowntree Theatre in February.

The University Society performs throughout the year and have appeared at The Gilbert and Sullivan International Festival in Harrogate in recent years, achieving some considerable success and favourable reviews.
